

## 2016-17 Catch-up Premium

### Pupil Premium Projected Analysis of Spend 2016-2017

Long Stratton High School also receives a further £ 11,500 Catch up Premium for the 2016-2017 financial year. This is allocated to all Year 7 pupils that did not achieve at least Level 4 in Reading and / or Maths at the end of Key Stage 2. This additional income into School supports the implementations of strategies that are aimed at raising attainment in Reading and Maths.
