Re: Year 8 Information Evening FAQ

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following on from our first Year 8 Information Evening, I wanted to thank you for your time in attending the sessions and the feedback that you gave us.

We have created a Frequently Asked Questions sheet in order to respond to some of the more common requests for additional information gained through the feedback sheets, and thought this would be beneficial to share with all.

1. **“How can I restrict the internet access for my child?”**

Depending on the platform and device they are using, this can vary slightly. A fantastic additional resource for guiding you through the different processes can be found at www.childnet.com → Parents and Carers → Hot Topics.

2. **“How do I access the Seneca revision platform?”**

By following the link (www.senecalearning.com) and selecting “Sign up” in the top right hand corner, pupils can create an account in minutes. Pupils should use their school email addresses to do so, as this will allow a greater range of functions to be used in collaboration with the school moving forwards.

If you were unable to attend the meeting and would like more information on Seneca, then please do not hesitate in contacting Miss Franklin.

3. **“Where can I find knowledge organisers for my child/Can they all be in one place?”**

As a result of this feedback, we will be collating all of the knowledge organisers so that they will be available in one place on the school website. A Parentmail will go out when this is available.

4. **“What methods can we use to support the mastery homework process?”**

Our strongest recommendation we can give would be to watch the complete video created by Mr Stevens (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=iBmGYUitOu0>) which gives a range of techniques. Pupils will also receive a range of subject specific guidance on techniques which suit their topics or subject areas, through both lesson contact time, mastery homework and revision for assessments.
